





#### **BMGR Info Notes**



- Military air-to-ground training and test activity::: since 1941
- Authority: <u>Congress</u>; Military Land Withdrawal Acts/Public Law
- Evolution: meet training needs—stay relevant to the user
- Shared land with USMC; separate operational execution, more "purple" on land management front
- A conundrum?
  - Bombing the desert in one hand; protecting the lands in the other
  - Huge part of our business is environmental stewardship in support of the military mission and continued use of the lands




### The Beauty of the BMGR

  - 10,000 years of habitation


Incumbent we effectively manage the natural and cultural resources in order to continue to support the military mission


